Traveler's Safety Awareness

As a traveler, you have a role in assuring the safety of yourself and your possessions. The following tips are not intended to alarm you, but are merely some suggestions for making your stay safe and enjoyable:

- ✓ Always store valuables in the safe deposit boxes located at the front desk of your hotel. There is no charge for this service.
- ✓ Use the observation port in your guest room door to identify people who may wish to enter your room. If you cannot properly identify someone as a hotel employee, friend, or associate, call the front desk prior to opening the door.
- ✓ Invite only people you know to your room. **DO NOT** give your key to others.
- ✓ Always use the main doors of the hotel to enter or leave. Be observant of traffic in the main drive and parking areas.
- ✓ Close the room door securely, lock the dead bolt, and use the safety lock whenever you are in your room.
- ✓ Guest room keys should be kept out of sight at all times. If you lose your key, report the loss to the front desk immediately.
- ✓ It is unwise to draw attention to yourself in public areas by displaying large amounts of cash or valuables.
- ✓ Be sure your vehicle has all valuables out of sight.
- ✓ Check to ensure windows, sliding glass doors, and connecting doors to other rooms are secured.
- ✓ Please report any suspicious activity you may see to management. **DO NOT** attempt to handle it yourself.
